

4.4.2 Procedures and policies for maintaining and utilizing physical academic and support facilities - laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc.

The infrastructure established by the management for the conduct of classes for UG and PG courses in the College are sufficient to meet the demands as per norms framed by the department of higher education.

The academic activities based on the curricula framed by the University, have been scrupulously carried out with the help of the subject experts at the College level, University (affiliated) level and other Universities level.

The faculty are being encouraged / supported by the administration of the College to take part in various academic programmes including participation in the conferences / symposia / seminars and they are being permitted to participate in the Orientation / Refresher Courses at various Universities and other recognized institutions of higher learning.

The Laboratories are equipped with the required instruments pertaining to the practical sessions of the UG/PG courses. The grants released by the UGC under various plan till XII Plan has been utilized for the augmentation of laboratory equipments.

Similarly, the library has been equipped with the books and journals as prescribed by the Heads of the department considering the requirement of the students. The funds from the UGC and the special fee collection from the students are being put into use for this purpose.

The sports / games activities in the college are being carried out by the Department of Physical Education by enabling the students to take part in various tournaments at inter-collegiate, district and other higher levels. The funds from the funding agencies, viz., UGC, Special Fee Collection has been put into this effect.

With the help of the management, the computers and accessories, which have been procured with the funds provided by the UGC / Management of Pachaiyappa's Trust, are being maintained regularly for the usage of the staff and students.
